

2005-06 WOMEN'S UNDER-18 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP



ATTENTION OWHA PLAYERS Female players born between 1988 and 1991 Inclusive

The Ontario Women's Hockey Association (OWHA) is selecting two teams to compete in the 2005-06 Women's Under 18 National Championship. Games will take place in Salmon Arm, British Columbia from **November 9 to 13, 2005**. Travel days are **November 8th and 14th**. The OWHA Pre-Event Camp will take place from November 4th to 8th. Each team may consist of 18 skaters and two goaltenders.

The process to select the 2005-06 OWHA teams will be as follows:

- The OWHA will facilitate the selection process to select Team Ontario 2005-06.
- OWHA Players (born between 1988 and 1991 inclusive) must apply for invitation to the evaluation process and be chosen to represent the OWHA at the 2005-06 Women's Under-18 National Championship.
- If you and/or your coach believe you may qualify as a potential team member, we encourage you to apply.
- Selected applicants will be invited to participate in the evaluation process.
- Preliminary camps are scheduled for **August 12, 13, 14** (Tomken Arena, Mississauga) and **September 9, 10, 11** (Hershey Centre Community Arena, Mississauga). Successful candidates from these camps will advance to the next camp **October 7, 8 & 9th** at Westwood Arena in Toronto.
- Selected applicants will be assigned to a team that will compete in an exhibition series of games during the weekend. Player evaluations will be completed and assessed by designated OWHA Evaluators.
- It is imperative that players must come to their designated camp in excellent condition.
- The camps must be run financially self-sufficient with funding coming from participant registration fees. The OWHA will endeavour to keep the costs to a minimum. The total direct financial commitment of a successful applicant is expected to be approximately \$1,800.00 per event. Please note: Individual travel and personal expenses to and from the camps are in addition to this amount and are the responsibility of the individual.
- In order to qualify for the OWHA teams, all individuals must participate in the selection process. OWHA evaluations will be the only determining criteria for selection to this team. Evaluations done by non-OWHA assigned individuals will not be part of the process.
- This opportunity is open to Ontario residents only. Players must be registered with the OWHA.

Guidelines for Player Eligibility (Note: "Branch" in Ontario refers to OWHA)

1. Players must be registered and play on an Ontario Women's Hockey Association team.
2. Players have to be born between the years 1988 and 1991 inclusive.
3. A player's domicile or actual residence must be located, for at least 90 days prior to the opening of the championship, within the recognized boundaries of the province or territory they are representing.
4. Students attending school on a full time basis outside of their province of permanent residence (where their parents live) during the year shall be permitted to compete for either their home province or the province in which the athlete attends school (if the athlete is attending school in Canada).
5. A non student athlete attending a recognized national training centre outside of her province of permanent residence, shall be permitted to compete for either their home province or the province in which they are attending the recognized training center.
6. If an athlete is eligible to compete for more than one Branch (home Branch and School/Training centre Branch) they are only permitted to participate in the selection process for one of the two Branches they are eligible to compete in.
7. **A letter of Recommendation from your OWHA coach must accompany your application.**
8. Players must be in condition to participate in a high tempo evaluation process, which will involve both ice time and a full day of activities.
9. Players must be prepared to make a full commitment to the program.

Interested players must complete and return the attached form and letter of recommendation from a coach with a cheque payable to the OWHA in the amount of \$200.00. This must be received in the OWHA office as soon as possible and no later than August 3, 2005.

The Ontario Women's Hockey Association (OWHA) is selecting a team for the Canada Winter Games March 4-10, 2007. The games will take place in Whitehorse, Yukon.

The process to select the OWHA team at the 2007 Canada Winter Games will be as follows:

- Selection camps will be held to identify the potential talent base.
- Preliminary camps will be held during the 2005-2006 season. Subsequent camps and training sessions will take place through to the event.
- If you and/or your coach think you qualify as a potential team member, we encourage you to apply.
- The OWHA will assign and facilitate these selection camps.
- One team will be chosen to represent the OWHA at the 2007 Canada Winter Games.
- Selected applicants will be assigned to a camp where they will be evaluated by designated OWHA evaluators. Successful candidates will advance to a subsequent camp.
- The camps must be run financially self-sufficient with funding coming from the participant registration fees. The OWHA will endeavour to keep the costs to a minimum. The direct financial commitment of a successful applicant is expected to be approximately \$ 1,800.00. Individual travel and personal expenses are in addition to this amount.
- In order to qualify for the OWHA team, all individuals must participate in the full selection process. OWHA evaluations will be the only determining criteria for selection to this team. Evaluations done by non-OWHA assigned individuals will not be part of the process.
- Open to Ontario residents only. Player must be registered with the OWHA.

Guidelines for Player Eligibility

- Players must be registered and play on an Ontario Women's Hockey Association team.
- Players have to be born in between the years 1989, 1990, 1991 and 1992.
- **Letter of Recommendation from your OWHA coach must accompany your application.**
- Players must be in condition to participate in a high tempo evaluation camp/festival, which involves ice time and a full day of activities.
- Players must be prepared to make a full commitment to the program.

Players Interested in the Canada Winter Games Team only must complete and return the attached form and letter of recommendation from a coach with a cheque payable to the OWHA in the amount of \$200.00. This must be received in the OWHA office by October 15, 2005.
